The Little Mermaid - A bronze statue by Edvard Eriksen, depicting a mermaid becoming human. The sculpture is displayed on a rock by the waterside at the Langelinie promenade in Copenhagen, Denmark.

Nyhavn Harbor is a 17th-century waterfront, canal and entertainment district in Copenhagen, Denmark. Brightly painted gabled buildings line the canal, adding a splash of color to dreary days and enticing visitors to stop in for a peek at the wares and a tasty bite in the restaurants and cafés.

REYKJAVIK

Hallgrimskirkja Church – is a famous church as an astounding landmark in the capital city of Iceland and the highest building in downtown Reykjavik, It built in the miid-20th century which combining elements of modernism and traditional Icelandic architecture. The exterior of the church is unique, with its tower inspired by natural landscapes in Iceland such as glaciers and volcanoes.

The Sun Voyager - is a sculpture made of stainless steel and resembles a Viking ship but its design is more abstract and represents the promise of undiscovered territory, a dream of hope, progress and freedom. It's situated on a promenade by the sea and enjoy the picturesque scenery with ocean and surrounding mountains, it becomes an iconic symbol of Iceland and popular tourist attraction.

Blue Lagoon – Visit the famous Blue Lagoon Geothermal Spa located in a lava field of Grindavik. Enjoy bathing and relaxing in the natural geothermal seawater which is rich in minerals and therapeutic elements. (Please prepare own swimming suite and cap)

Whale Watching Sightseeing Tour (Spring to Autumn: 1st Apr to 31st Oct) - Enjoy a sail out in one of the largest whale watching boats, you will have the best chance close up to meet and watch all kinds of wild giant whales, dolphins and marine wildlife in their natural habitat.

Northern Light Cruise (Winter: Nov to Mar) - Embark on a cruise tour and escape the coastline of Reykjavik to hunt and witness for the amazing and mesmerizing Aurora Borealis over the ocean. (Subject to local weather conditions and hence, sightings cannot be guaranteed)

Thingvellir National Park & Silver Lake - The Thingvellir area is praised as the national shrine of Iceland due to its great historical and geological significance, the original site of the oldest existing parliament in the world. It is also listed as a UNESCO world heritage site.

Gullfoss Waterfall - Gullfoss means "Golden Waterfall", because on a sunny day, the water takes on a golden-brown colour. This is due to the fact that it is glacial water and therefore carries lots of sediments that glacial ice has carved off the earth throughout the years.

Jokulsarion Glacier Lagoon with Amphibian Boat Tour (Only available in Spring to Autumn Season: April - October) Explore one of Iceland's most spectacular natural wonders up close by Amphibian Boat Tour experience. It is the most popular activity in Iceland and an experience you will never forget. (subject to weather conditions)

Vatnajökull Ice Cave (Blue Cave) (only available in Winter Season: November to March) - Hop into a super jeep for a ride to the foot of one of Vatnajokull's outlet glaciers and step into the magical ice world to admire the dazzling crystal ice cave. The cave glints with many wondrous colors, from sapphire blue to brilliant white, it's one of the most impressive natural wonders. Snowmobiling on a Glacier is a must-not be missed experience activity in the winter season.(subject to weather conditions)

Diamond Beach - The chunks of beautiful, clear ice scattered across the volcanic sand glistens like giant gemstones. Hence the name Diamond Beach, it is one of the most glorious places in Iceland.

Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach - With its enormous basalt stacks, roaring Atlantic waves, and stunning panoramas, Reynisfjara is widely considered to be the most beautiful attraction of Iceland's black sand beaches, the sand is ground down from black volcanic rocks, formed from lava that has cooled and solidified.

Hálsanefshellir Cave - is a huge sea cave located at the beach close to the small town Vík. The cave is exceptional because of octagonal basalt pillars at the cave entrance. The vertical columns are quite like Fingal's Cave on Staffa Island.

D3 Plane Wreck - a wreckage of a US Navy DC-3 airplane located on a black sand beach. The airplane crashed in 1973, fortunately with all passengers surviving. Its unique history and spectacular landscape, become a popular tourist spot.
