MUNICH

- Marienplatz with the New City Hall is the world-famous center of the Bavarian capital. It has been the city's main square since 1158.
- **Ingolstadt Village** Enjoy luxury open-air shopping with more than 110 boutiques lining open-air, pedestrianised streets, the Village offers savings of up to 60% on the former recommended retail price of a unique edit of German and international fashion and lifestyle brands all year round.

PRIEN

- Lake Chiemsee is a freshwater lake in Bavaria. It is often called "the Bavarian Sea". There are three islands on the lake, the biggest island is Herreninsel, referred to as the "Men's Island", Fraueninsel referred to the "Women's Island" and the tiny Krautinsel referred to "Cabbage Island". Since 1954, the lake has also been a protected nature reserve.
- Herrenchiemsee (New Palace) is a complex of royal buildings on Herreninsel, the largest island in the Chiemsee lake, in southern Bavaria, Germany. The island, formerly the site of an Augustinian monastery, was purchased by King Ludwig II of Bavaria in 1873. The king had the premises converted into a residence then he had the New Herrenchiemsee Palace (Neues Schloss) erected started in 1878, based on the model of Versailles in honor of King Louis XIV of France. Highlights include the grandiose Great Hall of Mirrors, many fascinating staterooms, breathtaking marble State Staircase, and a surprising "magic table".

ZUGSPITE

Zugspitze - is 2,962 metres, the Zugspitze is Germany's highest mountain. Home to one of Germany's last glaciers and belongs to the Wetterstein range of the Northern Limestone Alps. A cable car and cogwheel train can take you on a breathtaking journey to the summit. This is where you will get to see more than 400 natural snow-clad mountains spread across four countries, including Germany, Austria, Italy, and Switzerland. There is a summit cross on the top of Zugspitze since 1851, is the signature feature of the Zugspitze.

FÜSSEN

- Neuschwanstein Castle the name means "New Swan Castle," is often
 referred to as the "Disney Castle," the "Sleeping Beauty Castle" and the
 "Cinderella Castle" and well known as one of TOP 10 castles in the world.
 Surrounded by cliffs, a moat, and a charming little town, the castle appears
 untouched by time. It stands as an everlasting testament to the amazing
 wonders of King Ludwig II, who commissioned the building in 1868.
- St. Mang Church Formerly a Benedictine abbey, it was built in Bavaria in Germany at a point of medieval strategic importance. This elegant church's interiors are embellished with several spectacular religious paintings and artworks.

LINDERHOF

 Linderhof Palace - is the smallest of the three palaces built by King Ludwig II of Bavaria and the only one which he lived to see completed. The castle is full of surprises, but the Hall of Mirrors is the highlight of this splendid attraction.

ROTHENBURG OB DER TAUBER

- Romantic Road connects a number of beautiful sights and villages concentrated in the south of Germany. The 460-kilometer route takes in picturesque landscapes, fairy-tale castles, and lovely historic towns.
- **St James's Church** is the largest church in the wall-enclosed medieval city of Rothenburg ob der Tauber in northern Bavaria in Germany. This High Gothic church is filled with art in addition to the world-famous Holy Blood Altar (Heilig-Blut-Altar) by Tilman Riemenschneider — Germany's most renowned woodcarver.

NUREMBERG

- St Sebald Church is a medieval church in Nuremberg, Germany. Along with Frauenkirche (Our Lady's Church) and St. Lorenz, it is one of the most important churches of the city, and also one of the oldest. St. Sebald has a valuable collection of art, including many pre-Reformations treasures.
- Bamberg's Smoke Beer is known for its special beer and many local breweries and beer gardens. The taste of "Bamberg smoked beer of traditional production" is determined by the production of the smoked malt. From around 1935, the Bamberg breweries Schlenkerla and Spezial were the only ones who remained true to the traditional way of producing smoked beer a

WÜRZBURG

Würzburg Residence And Court Garden - built in 18th century, is one of the most spectacular royal palaces in Europe and surrounded by wonderful gardens. They all created timeless works of art in the vestibule, staircase, While Hall and Imperial Hall. Since 1981, the Residence has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site in recognition of its outstanding Baroque art, design, and architecture.

FRANKFURT

Frankfurt Cathedral - Officially named the Imperial Cathedral of Saint Bartholomew. It is the largest religious building in the city and a former collegiate church. As one of the major buildings of the Empire's history, it was a symbol of national unity, especially in the 19th century. The present church building is the third church on the same site.
