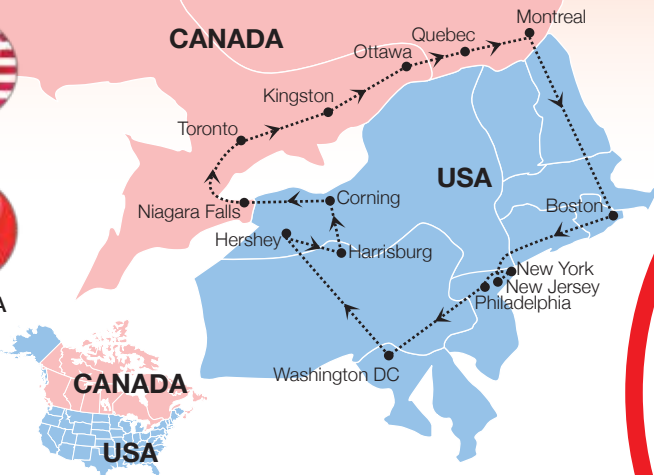

- **Liberty State Park** – to view the 151 feet high of Statue of Liberty- The Lady with the lamp represents democracy, as well as the Ellis Island.
- **Empire State Building** – The Empire State Building is an American cultural icon. It is designed in the distinctive Art Deco style and has been named as one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World by the American Society of Civil Engineers.
- **Time Square** – Brightly adorned with billboards and advertisements, Times Square is sometimes referred to as The Crossroads of the World, The Center of the Universe, the heart of The Great White Way, and the “Heart of the World”.

PHILADELPHIA

- **Independence National Historical Park** – is a United States National Park in Philadelphia that preserves several sites associated with the American Revolution and the nation's founding history.
- **The Gettysburg Address and his Independence Hall** – is where born the United States Declaration of Independence and the State United States Constitution were debated and adopted.

BALTIMORE

- **Baltimor's Inner Harbor** – which one of America's oldest seaports since the 1600s. The Baltimore Harbor has been welcoming people, ships and goods from all over the world.

- **Lincoln Memorial** – The Lincoln Memorial is an American national monument built to honor the 16th President of the United States, Abraham Lincoln. NIAGARA FALLS

- **Maid of the Mist** – The boat starts off at a calm part of the Niagara River, near the Rainbow Bridge and takes its passengers past the American and Bridal Veil Falls, then into the dense mist of spray inside the curve of the Horseshoe Falls also known as the Canadian Falls.

**Subject to weather and river conditions otherwise it will be replaced by Journey Behind The Falls.*

BOSTON

- **Quincy Market** – is a historic market complex near Faneuil Hall in downtown Boston, Massachusetts. It was constructed in 1824-26 and named in honor of Mayor Josiah Quincy, who organized its construction without any tax or debt.

TORONTO

- **CN Tower** – The CN Tower is a 553.33 meter high (1,815.4 ft) concrete communications and observation tower in downtown Toronto, Ontario, Canada.

KINGSTON
