

ZURICH

- Fraumünster Church The church was built from the middle of the 9th century on the opposite
 side of the river to the Grossmunster. Today, many visitors are attracted by the five stained glass
 windows prepared by Marc Chagall in the 1960's as well as by the rosette in the south transept.
- Bahnhofstrasse Bahnhofstrasse is Zurich's main downtown street and one of the world's most
 expensive and exclusive shopping avenues. In 2011, a study named the Bahnhofstrasse the most
 expensive street for retail property in Europe, and the third most expensive worldwide. In 2016
 ranked ninth.

LUCERNE

- Lion Monument The Lion Monument, or the Lion of Lucerne, is a sculpture in Lucerne, Switzerland, designed by Bertel Thorvaldsen and hewn in 1820–21 by Lukas Ahorn. It commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution, when revolutionaries stormed the Tuileries Palace in Paris, France. Mark Twain praised the sculpture of a mortally-wounded lion as "the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world."
- Wooden Chapel Bridge The Kapellbrücke (literally, Chapel Bridge) is a covered wooden footbridge spanning diagonally across the Reuss River in the city of Lucerne in central Switzerland. Named after the nearby St. Peter's Chapel, the bridge is unique since it contains a number of interior paintings dating back to the 17th century, although many of them were destroyed along with most of the centuries old bridge in a 1993 fire. Subsequently restored, the Kapellbrücke is the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe,as well as the world's oldest surviving truss bridge. It serves as the city's symbol and as one of Switzerland's main tourist attractions.

INTERLAKEN

Luzern - Interlaken Express – The panoramic journey between Lucerne and Interlaken could offers
comfort and magnificent views through modern panoramic windows. En-route, you'll admire the
breathtaking Alpine panorama, sparkling lakes and idyllic countryside.

MATTERHORN

- Zermatt A car-free village and in the middle of an enormous hiking and ski region makes it one of
 the world's most attractive vacation villages. The ski region encompasses 54 mountain railways and
 lifts as well as 360 kilometers of pistes.
- Matterhorn at 4,478 metres the majestic Matterhorn, a symbol of Switzerland. The pyramid shaped colossus of a mountain, which is very difficult to climb, is said to be the most-photographed mountain in the world.
- Gornegrat Gornergrat at an altitude of 3,089 m. Gornergrat Bahn (GGB) Railway, the world's first
 fully electrified cog railway. Today it is a modern, eco-friendly railway. The ride reveals especially
 attractive views of the mountains around Zermatt, including the Matterhorn. The views from the
 observation platform on the Gornergrat: 29 peaks above 4,000 m, including the Monte Rosa,
 Matterhorn and Weisshorn as well as the Gorner Glacier, the second-largest in Europe, and many
 other summits capped in ice and snow.
- Rotenboden Take 10 minutes walks to Riffelsee Lake from Rotenboden station, is a great subject for photos, especially on windless days in the early morning or at dusk. The smooth surface of the water will perfectly reflect the Matterhorn. (Subject to weather condition)

ISELTWALD

Lake Brienz – One of Switzerland's most beautiful and deep lakes is called Lake Brienz. It's recognised for its bizarre turquoise colour, which draws a slew of tourists to its coastlines. South Korean television show "Crash Landing on You" is hugely popular and has won over audiences all over the world. The usage of Switzerland's stunning scenery and scenic sites plays a significant role in the show's visual appeal and narrative. One of the most popular scenes in CLOY among viewers was in episode 3, when Jeong-hyeok reminisces about his time alone playing the piano on this wooden "stage" on Lake Brienz. Se-ri also happened to hear him playing while boating on the same lake during a significant time in her life. Iseltwald and Lake Brienz are therefore connected in the programme.

BERN

Bear Pit - The Bern Bear Park is a unique recreation area at the lower end of the old town of Bern. It is open around the clock and free for all visitors. Brown bears have been living in this generously-sized enclosure on the banks of the river Aare since 2009.

GRUYÈRES

- La Maison du Gruyère is a village cheese dairy providing the opportunity of viewing the hand-made production of the cheese "Le Gruyère AOP".
- Gruyères Castle Built-in the late 13th Century, Perched atop a small hill with the mighty Swiss Alps in the background. A Swiss heritage site today, it is home to an art museum with paintings by notable artists like Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot, Barthélemy Menn, and many others. A number of temporary exhibitions, cultural events, and music festivals are also regularly organized at its premises. Walk along the outside rampart which goes to the back of the château. The back has some beautiful French gardens and views of the surrounding town.

MONTREUX

Chillon Castle - An island castle located on Lake Geneva, south of Veytaux in the canton of Vaud. Successively occupied by the house of Savoy then by the Bernese from 1536 until 1798, it now belongs to the State of Vaud and is classified as a Swiss Cultural Property of National Significance.

GENEVA

- Lake Geneva Jet d'Eau Water Fountain one of the tallest fountain in the world. The fountain presence gives the power to the place and its majesty serves as a reminder that the area is a powerful and well organized country.
- Flower Clock The clock, which is located in a corner of the Jardin Anglais, was first erected in 1955 and contains over 12,000 flowers and plants. The flower arrangements change with the seasons. The Swiss-accurate time displayed on the floral clock is transmitted by satellite, so it is not only beautiful but also functions as a timepiece. Another significant aspect is that the seconds hand is the longest in the world at 2.5 metres long!

CHAMONIX

Ride Aiguille Du Midi Cable Car to view Mont Blanc - Getting a breathtaking view of Mont Blanc by taking the Aiguille du Midi cable car from Chamonix's center to the mountain's top slopes at a height of 3,842 meters. It is France's highest cable car. It's an opportunity to explore the high mountains in perfect safety. Enjoy distinctive sights like the Espace Vertical, the tallest climbing museum ever constructed, at the summit of the Aiguille du Midi. Or the Espace Mont-Blanc, which is well-protected by huge picture windows and offers views of the surrounding mountains. Above all, don't miss "Step Into the Void" with its glass box at 3842m, the tallest attraction in Europe. 1000m of emptiness beneath your feet, guaranteed thrills!
