MUNICH

- Frauenkirche or the Church of Our Dear Lady, is the biggest church in the city. The
 enormous Gothic-style Cathedral was completed in 1488, with the domes crowning its
 towers in 1525 at 99 metres in height, were finally covered with peculiar green domes.
- Rathaus Glockenspiel it chimes and re-enacts two stories from the 16th century to the
 amusement. It consists of 43 bells and 32 life-sized figures. The top half of the
 Glockenspiel tells the story of the marriage of the local Duke Wilhelm V to Renata of
 Lorraine. Second story: Schäfflertanz (the coopers' dance).

FÜSSEN

Neuschwanstein Castle – Neuschwanstein, the name means "New Swan Castle," is
often referred to as the "Disney Castle," the "Sleeping Beauty Castle" and the "Cinderella
Castle" and well known as one of TOP 10 castles in the world. Surrounded by cliffs, a
moat, and a charming little town, the castle appears untouched by time. It stands as an
everlasting testament to the amazing wonders of King Ludwig II, who commissioned the
building in 1868.

INNSBRUCK

- Golden Roof or Goldenes Dachl is a landmark structure located in the Old Town
 (Altstadt) section of Innsbruck, Austria. It is considered the city's most famous symbol.
 Completed in 1500, the roof was decorated with 2,657 fire-gilded copper tiles for Emperor
 Maximilian I to mark his wedding to Bianca Maria Sforza. The Emperor and his wife used
 the balcony to observe festivals, tournaments, and other events that took place in the
 square below.
- The Hofkirche (Court Church) The Court Church impresses with the 28 larger-than-life figures of the bronze-cast Black Statues, which guard the magnifi-cent tomb of Emperor Maximilian I. The 40 larger than life-sized statues have, however, never been completed and only 28 were finally brought into being. A further highlight in this

 Lucerne to Interlaken Express – The panoramic journey between Lucerne and Interlaken could offers comfort and magnificent views through modern panoramic windows. En-route, you'll admire the breathtaking Alpine panorama, sparkling lakes and idyllic countryside.

SCHILTHORN

- Lauterbrunnen Valley The Staubbach Falls, arguably the most renowned among the 72 waterfalls in Lauterbrunnen Valley, holds the title of the third highest waterfall, with a height of 297 meters.
- Schilthorn situated above the charming village of Mürren and the Lauterbrunnen Valley. Standing at 2,970 meters above sea level, it offers breathtaking 360-degree views of over 200 mountain peaks. The summit also hosts the Piz Gloria revolving restaurant. The Schilthorn became famous as a location for the 1969 James Bond film "On Her Majesty's Secret Service".

SCHILTHORN

- Piz Gloria Observation Deck Enjoy the Earth's most breathtaking views of Monch, Eiger, and Jungfrau (UNESCO World Heritage) are visible, extending to the Jura Mountains, Mt. Titlis, Germany's Black Forest, sometimes even Mont Blanc. Additionally, the beautiful lakes of Brienz and Thun can be seen.
- Skyline Walk The Skyline Walk is constructed of steel and reinforced glass, located at
 the Birg middle station lets you stare into the abyss below to take in the sights of the Alps
 and the mountain peaks.
- Thrill Walk is a breathtaking 200 meter long structure made of steel, glass and mesh
 which leads down into the perpendicular walls of the imposing rock massif. The steel
 structure clings to the rock before swerving under the observation deck and cableway to
 end below the cable car station. Features including a crawl-through tunnel,
 glass-bottomed floor, rope and cattle grid lend an additional frisson of thrill to this
 spine-tingling adventure.
- 360° Restaurant Piz Gloria its own axis in 45 minutes, is the first revolving restaurant
 in the Alps. Piz Gloria Restaurant offers the best views of the magnificent peaks, Eiger,
 Mönch and Jungfrau and the food is just as spectacular!

MATTERHORN

- Matterhorn at 4,478 metres the majestic Matterhorn, a symbol of Switzerland. The
 pyramid shaped colossus of a mountain, which is very difficult to climb, is said to be the
 most-photographed mountain in the world.
- Tasch situated at 1449 m above sea level, located in the middle of the Mattertal valley near Zermatt. In Tasch every visitor to Zermatt changes to the Matterhorn-Gotthard railroad
- Zermatt A car-free village and in the middle of an enormous hiking and ski region
 makes it one of the world's most attractive vacation villages. The ski region encompasses
 54 mountain railways and lifts as well as 360 kilometers of pistes.
- Gornergrat Gornergrat at an altitude of 3,089 m. Gornergrat Bahn (GGB) Railway, the world's first fully electrified cog railway. Today it is a modern, eco-friendly railway. The ride reveals especially attractive views of the mountains around Zermatt, including the Matterhorn. The views from the observation platform on the Gornergrat: 29 peaks above 4,000 m, including the Monte Rosa, Matterhorn and Weisshorn as well as the Gorner Glacier, the second-largest in Europe, and many other summits capped in ice and snow.
- Rotenboden Take 10 minutes walks to Riffelsee Lake from Rotenboden station, is a
 great subject for photos, especially on windless days in the early morning or at dusk. The
 smooth surface of the water will perfectly reflect the Matterhorn.
