MUNICH

- Frauenkirche Church is the biggest church in the city. The enormous Gothic-style Cathedral was completed in 1488, with the domes crowning its towers in 1525 at 99 metres in height, were finally covered with peculiar green domes.
- Oktoberfest Is the world's largest beer festival in Munich. It features Bavarian food, music, and beer, attracting visitors from all over the world. The festival began in 1810 as a royal wedding celebration.
- Olympic Stadium Built for the 1972 Summer Olympics, is a striking architectural landmark known for its distinctive tent-like roof design. It has hosted numerous events and remains a key cultural and sports venue in Munich.
- BMW Welt Is a showcase and experience center in Munich, Germany, where
 visitors can explore the brand's history, innovations, and future models. It features
 interactive exhibits, car displays, and offers test drives of BMW vehicles. The
 center is also connected to the BMW Museum and the BMW Group headquarters.

FUSSEN

Neuschwanstein Castle - Neuschwanstein was built for the Bavarian king Ludwig II (1845 - 1886); it was begun in 1868 but never fully completed. The king saw his castle as a monument to the culture and concept of monarchy prevailing in the Middle Ages, which he greatly admired and wanted to recreate. Built and furnished in medieval styles but equipped with the latest technology of the day, it is the most famous historicist building in the world.

SALZBURG

- Salzburg Is the Austrian city of Salzburg fortress of a castle located in the
 castle hill, the city landmark of Salzburg. Founded in 1077, one of Europe's largest
 medieval castle and one of the most popular attractions in Austria.
- Swarovski Crystal Worlds Is an immersive attraction featuring the iconic "Giant" sculpture, the "Crystal Cloud" installation, and sparkling gardens. It combines art, nature, and Swarovski crystals, offering exhibitions and a store with crystal jewelry and collectibles.
- Mirabell Palace Is one of the main attractions. It was built about 1606 outside the medieval walls of Salzburg according to Italian and French models by the Salzburg Archbishop Wolf Dietrich. The movie "The Sound of Music," one of the viewfinder here. Mirabell Palace is a popular wedding location.
- Mozart's Birthplace Museum Is a beige 6-storey building, 27 January 1756 at the birth of genius musician Mozart. Mozart's father was a violinist, the family from 1747 to 1773 lived in the third floor of this building. Mozart was born on Getreidegasse status is the most eye-catching building, yellow facades, with the red and white Austrian flag.

HALLSTATT

 Hallstatt - A village on Lake Hallstatt's western shore in Austria's mountainous Salzkammergut region. Its 16th-century Alpine houses and alleyways are home to cafes and shops.

VIENNA

- Schönbrunn Palace is a former imperial summer residence located in Vienna, Austria. The 1,441-room Baroque palace is one of the most important architectural, cultural and historical monuments in the country. Since the mid-1950s it has been a major tourist attraction.
- Hofburg Palace is the former imperial palace in the centre of Vienna. Part of
 the palace forms the official residence and workplace of the President of Austria.
 It was the principal imperial winter residence, as Schönbrunn Palace was their
 summer residence.
