- **King Crab Fishing Trip** - A totally unforgettable experience awaits you on the frozen fjords of Kirkenes. This is your chance to catch, learn how to cook, and most importantly eat this mysterious creature. The Artic King Crab is one of the most sort after meals in top restaurants, and yet here, you get to eat the best and the freshest, pulled from the fjord in front of your eyes. You all take part in helping to saw the hole the ice and bring up the catch. You will see how the crab is prepared by your master guide. Although presentation is simple, the superb, white leg meat and claws with their particularly juicy and naturally sweet taste make this meal in a league of its own.
- **Aurora Borealis Hunting** - The Aurora Borealis is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing high-energy electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules, releasing energy and producing brilliant lights. The best season to hunt for the Northern Lights is from Sep till Apr with the most frequent sightings occurring between 6pm to 1am.

The opportunity to witness this visual wonder of nature, it is subjected on weather conditions such as solar activity, cloud cover and other factors and cannot be guaranteed. However, sighting is not confined to this schedule as the "dancing green lights" may show up randomly during your stay in Lapland.

Tour Manager will guide customer where to view the Aurora – it can be surrounding hotel area or travel by coach to secluded area, which ever option applicable.

Note : Northern Lights (Aurora) is a natural phenomenon, Golden Destination unable to guarantee the appearance of during your visit at anytime.

- **Snow Hotel** - is situated 8km outside Kirkenes in the secluded wilds of Northern Norway since 2006. Dreamlike rooms uniquely carved by master ice sculptors from around the world. Hotel is built completely of snow and ice, and each spring melts back into the fjord. Snowhotel is one of the most famous igloo hotels in Norway, and in the world.

FINLAND - SAARISELKA

- **Glass Igloo** - The glass igloo has become a feature and symbols of Finland. Even though we live this far north, we can never guarantee the appearance of the Northern Lights. However, sleeping under a glass roof multiplies your chances of seeing the renowned Aurora Borealis. In the warm glass igloo, you can lie comfortably in bed, look up and capture the aurora waves in the sky. Enjoy the happy and romantic moments.
- **Husky Dog Farm** - also known as the Polar husky, is Lapland's most heartfelt friend. Visit the huskies Farm to learn about their daily routines and training. Husky sledding is a truly thrilling and memorable experience.

- **Fishing Trip**- Rovaniemi in Lapland, Finland, a true Finnish experience is ice fishing. An activity that can be experienced a new skill of ice fishing on river ice or on wilderness lake's ice.
- **Tankavaara Gold Museum** - is a village and a tourist attraction in the municipality of Sodankylä in Lapland, Finland. Tankavaara is home for the only international museum in the World displaying past and present of gold panning and prospecting. The basic exhibition presents the history of gold prospecting in Lapland.

FINLAND – ROVANIEMI

- **Santa Claus Village** - is an Amusement Park in Rovaniemi in the Lapland region of Finland. It was opened in 1985. There are many souvenir shops as well as Santa's Main Post Office, programme service companies and cafes and restaurants in the Santa Claus Village. And of course, Santa is there too, in his chamber every day of the year.
- **Santa's Main Post Office** - is a tourist destination in Santa Claus Village in the Arctic Circle. In Santa Claus' Main Post Office visitors can also read letters sent to Santa. A letter writer can arrange to have a letter mailed to them from Santa before Christmas. This special Arctic Circle postmark is a popular collectable and souvenir.
- **Arctic Circle** - It is almost impossible not to cross the Arctic Circle in Rovaniemi. Most do it in Santa Claus Village, where it is marked and even a certificate confirming the feat can be acquired.

FINLAND - RANUA

- **Ranua Wildlife Park** - is a zoo that opened in 1983 in the municipality of Ranua, Lapland, Finland. The zoo's animals consist of approximately 50 wild animal species and 200 individuals, including top predators such as lynx, brown bears and wolves but also European moose and deers. The zoo has Finland's only polar bears in artificial snow.


