

#### **TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:**

#### **NARA**

- ◆ Nara Todaiji is one of Japan's most famous temples and a landmark of Nara. Located in Nara Park, in central Nara. Todaiji was constructed in 752 as the head temple of all provincial Buddihist temples.
- ◆ Deer Park is home to hundreds of freely roaming deer. Nara's nearly 1200 deer have become a symbol of the city and have been designated a natural treasure.

#### **OSAKA**

 Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade - a covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop.

#### **KYOTO**

- Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.
- Fushimi Inari Shrine is an important Shinto shrine in southern Kyoto. It is famous for its thousands of vermilion tori gates, which straddle a network of traits behind its main buildings. Fushimi Inari is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice. Foxes are thought to be Inari's messengers, resulting in many fox statues across the shrine grounds.

#### **HAKONE**

- ◆ **Mount Fuji** Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times, with the height of 3776m high
- ◆ Lake Ashi Pirate Ship was formed in the caloera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last cruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji.
- Oshino Hakkai is underground water from Mt. Fuji. It begins with the snow on the top of Mt. Fuji. The water travel over 60 years, and finally spring at Oshino Hakkai

### TOKYO

- Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple) The temple is dedicated to the fod of mercy. Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And youcould walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- ◆ **Tokyo Disneyland** Tokyo Disneyland was the first Disney resort to be opened outside of America. The park is devided into 7 areas and the centerpiece of Tokyo Disneyland, like most Disney resort, is Cinderella's Castle Tokyo Disneyland places regularly as one of the top three most visited theme parks in the world.

### 观光景点:

- 奈良东大寺 是日本最有名和历史上最重要的寺庙之一,同时它也是奈良的 地标建筑及世界上最大的木结构建筑。
- 神廳公园 公园内巨树丛立,还有历史悠久的古迹、花草、山林及岩石等。 有驯鹿成群,共有1200多只,散布于山间、林下或寺庙的池群,是奈良观光 的象征。

### 大阪

心斋桥商店街 - 繁华的购物街,遍布有趣的商店和餐馆。

- 清水寺 历史悠久的寺庙,整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式 古老建筑及商店、摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品、陶瓷、日本娃娃等、不胜 枚举。
- 伏见稻荷神社 是位于京都南面的重要神社。以其主建筑物后成千上的朱红鸟 居们闻名。山径延伸进入神圣的稻荷山,山高233米。稻荷是神道教诸神中的农 业之神,而狐狸被视为神明稻荷的使者。因此,在稻荷神社中可以看到许多尊 狐狸的雕像。伏见稻荷神社具有悠久的渊源,早于794年首都迁往京都。

### 箱根

- 富士山 富士山海拔3776米,是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟,为其他山峰所不 及,量圆锥形的山姿十分优美,常常被用来作为绘画和文学的创作题材,它作 为日本的象征, 名杨全世界。
- 芦之湖海盗船 乘海盗船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖,湖山相映,不同的季节 有不同的景致和情趣。
- 忍野八海 有富士山需水渗入地底后满出的八个池子而形的特别景观、是白佳 名泉之一。加上以富士山为背景的美丽景致,确实令人沉迷。

- **送草雷门观音寺** 建于7世纪的佛庙,其象征物是风雷神门,上面挂着写有"雷 门"两个字的大红灯笼,这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客,终年熙熙攘攘。您 也可在该寿前的热闹街道"仲见世"购物,此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当地 小吃的日式店铺。
- 东京迪士尼乐园 在迪斯尼正门的中心,可以看到高耸的"灰姑娘城"这座主 建筑,然后在它的周围还建造了多种主题的游乐场和游乐馆,有冒险宫、世界 著名故、传说宫、有风景宫、闲游宫、幻想宫等。在东京迪斯尼乐园里还可以 看到大型的游行表演,这些表演让您身同进入迪斯尼童话世界、并流涟忘返。
