

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

NARA

Todai-ji Temple - Listed as a World Heritage Site, Todai-ji was constructed in 728 AD following the imperial decree of Emperor Shomu, who greatly valued Buddhism. Todai-ji serves as the main temple among the 68 provincial temples across the country. It is said to be named "Todai-ji" because it was built to the east of the capital, Heijokyo. Inside the world's largest wooden building, the Todai-ji Daibutsuden (Great Buddha Hall), which is 57 meters wide and 50 meters deep, stands a Buddha statue over 15 meters tall.

OSAKA

- Osaka Castle It is a symbol of Osaka, encompassing thirteen buildings that have been designated as Important Cultural Properties by the Japanese government.
- Sinsaibashi Shopping Arcade A bustling shopping street filled with interesting shops and restaurants.

KYOTO

Kiyomizu Temple - is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.

HAMAMATSU

Lake Hamana - is a brackish lagoon in Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan. Formerly a true lake, it is now connected to the Pacific Ocean by a channel. As an internal body of water, it is considered Japan's tenth-largest lake. It spans the boundaries of the cities of Hamamatsu and Kosai.

HAKONE

- Mt. Fuji 5th Station At 3776 meters above sea level, the Fuji Subaru Line 5th Station offers a commanding view of the Fuji Five Lakes area below, making it a popular spot even for those who are not intent on climbing the mountain.
- Lake Ashi Pirate Cruise Was formed in the caldera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji.
- Owakudani an area with active volcanic zone where sulphurous fumes, its "Black jewel eggs" cooked in the area's thermal heat sources, are a Hakone specially.

TOKYO

- Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple) is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- Shinjuku Centered around the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building and a street lined with skyscrapers and office buildings, Shinjuku is known for its shopping and entertainment facilities. At its heart lies Kabukicho, renowned as the city that never sleeps, making it one of Japan's rare entertainment districts.

观光景点:

奈良

◆ 东大寺 - 被列入《世界遗产名录》的东大寺是公元728年遵照重视佛教的圣武天皇圣旨建造的。东大寺是全国68所国分寺的总寺院,据说是因为建在首都平城京以东,所以被称作"东大寺"。正面宽度57米、深50米的世界最大的木造建筑东大寺大佛殿内,放置着高15米以上的佛像。

箱根

- ◆ 大阪城堡 是大阪的象征,包含了十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- ◆ 心斋桥 一条超级热闹的购物街、街上充满有趣的商店和餐厅。

京都

◆ 清水寺 - 历史悠久的寺庙,整座建筑完全不用铁打钉琐。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老。 建筑及商店,摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品,陶瓷,日本娃娃等,不胜枚举。

演松

◆ **演名湖** - 为位于日本静冈县滨松市、湖西市的潟湖。 南部与海相通,为日本第十大湖。

箱根

- ◆ 富士山 富士山海拔3776米,是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟,为其它山峰所不及, 呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美,常常被用来作为绘画和文学的创作题材,它作为日本的 象征,名扬全世界。
- ◆ **芦之湖海盗船** 乘海盗船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖,湖山相映。不同的季节有不同的景致和情趣。
- ◆ 箱根大攝谷 为3000年前火山爆发的火山口,每当起风时,带着硫磺味的浓烟弥漫期间时,形成特殊景观。登上山顶,有用火山温泉煮熟的「黑鸡蛋」,据日本人说吃一个可长寿7年。

东京

- ★ 淺草雷门观音寺 建于7世纪的佛庙,其象征物是风雷神门,上面挂着写有"雷门"两个字的大红灯笼,这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客,终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寿前的热闹街道"仲见世"购物,此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当地小吃的日式店铺
- ◆ 新宿 东京都政府大楼、高楼大厦林立的事务所一条街。以购物、娱乐综合设施为中心的新宿、被誉为不夜城的歌舞伎町为中心的日本少有的娱乐区。
