## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### KOBE

- ◆ **Arima Onsen** - It was built in the 8th century by the Buddhist monks built by the sanatorium. It is one of Japan's three famous springs (Lower Lu Hot Springs and Kusatsu Hot Springs), which is located in the northern part of Kobe City, Hyogo. There is a horse hot spring water quality rich mineral, spring water containing about 2 times the concentration of sea salt, divided into spring like rust red "golden spring" and colorless transparent carbon spring "silver spring".

### KYOTO

- ◆ **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple. Nishijin Textile Centre (Kimono Show) - Here you can find a great variety of works created in the Nishijin Spirit, like Kimono & Kimono Sashes. And you could enjoy a Kimono show in the centre.
- ◆ **Ninenzaka Path & Sannenzaka Path** - Ninenzaka Path and Sannenzaka Path are two iconic pedestrian streets in Kyoto, Japan, known for their historical charm and traditional architecture. They are situated near the famous Kiyomizu-dera Temple and are popular destinations for both tourists and locals seeking a glimpse into Kyoto's past.

### OSAKA

- ◆ **Osaka Museum of Housing and Living** - Is a remarkable facility located in the northeastern part of the Kita Area. The museum has re-created buildings and streets that show what life was like in Osaka in the past. A model of the entire city during the Edo Period, the only one of its kind in Japan, is housed in the building. Visitors can learn all about Osaka's development, experiencing via interactive exhibits the different ways of life in the city during different periods of its history.
- ◆ **Osaka Castle** - It is one of Japan's most famous castles.
- ◆ **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - It is said to be the longest in Japan. Once inside the arcade, approx. 600 stores; old-fashioned diners, delicatessen, knife shops of long tradition, a tea store established in 1868, tofu, croquettes, chinaware and kimono.

### NARA

- ◆ **Todai-ji Temple** - Is one of Japan's most famous and historically temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site as "Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara", together with seven other sites including temples, shrines and places .the Big Buddha Hall is the world's largest wooden building, despite the fact that the present reconstruction of 1692 is only two thirds of the original temple hall's size.

## 观光景点:

### 神户

- ◆ **有马温泉** - 是日本关西地区最古老的温泉。位于兵库县神户市北区有马町，历史悠久，素有「神户之腹地」之称是日本三大名泉（下吕温泉、草津温泉）之一。有马温泉的水质富涵矿物质，泉水中含有约为海水2倍浓度的铁盐泉，分为泉色似铁锈红的“金泉”和无色透明碳酸泉的“银泉”。

### 京都

- ◆ **清水寺** - 历史悠久的寺庙，整座建筑完全不用铁打钉琐。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店，摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品，陶瓷，日本娃娃等，不胜枚举。
- ◆ **二, 三年坂** - 自古因是通往清水寺的参拜道路之一而繁荣兴盛。斜坡的两侧并排着深具京都风情的日式传统建筑物，其中大多都是伴手礼商店。再加上附近因有高台寺及八坂之塔等著名寺院，所以成为了以清水寺为主要造访景点的热门观光路线。

### 大阪

- ◆ **大阪人居博物馆 (大阪生活今昔馆)** - 是位于北部地方东北部的一座颇具特色的博物馆。该馆内的建筑物和街道模型再现了大阪人过去的的生活。博物馆内收藏了一座江户时代大阪的城市模型，这也是日本唯一一座保留下来的城市模型。来这里参观的游客们可以透过陈列品来想像不同历史时期人们的生活方式，从而全面地了解大阪的发展历程。
- ◆ **大阪城堡** - 是大阪的象征，它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- ◆ **心斋桥购物街** - 大阪最大的购物区，也是日本最长的天缝式购物街，集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店，既有日本菜，也可以品尝到中国、韩国、亚洲、美洲和欧洲等世界各个国家、各个地区不同的风味呢。

### 奈良

- ◆ **东大寺** - 被列入《世界遗产名录》的东大寺是公元728年遵照重视佛教的圣武天皇圣旨建造的。东大寺是全国68所国分寺的总寺院，据说是因为建在首都平城京以东，所以被称作“东大寺”。正面宽度57米、深50米的世界最大的木造建筑东大寺大佛殿内，放置着高15米以上的佛像。
